Terrain: calcareo ghiaioso con alcuni depositi argillosi

Harvest: manual


Vinification: The grapes are destemmed and gently dropped by gravity into a slow and gentle pneumatic press. Must extraction is limited to 60% to preserve only the quintessence and the best aromatic potential. Alcoholic fermentation takes place in temperature-controlled vats

Refinement: on fine lees in temperature-controlled containers

Color: bianco pallido, cristallino e con riflessi brillanti

Fragrance: clean and sparkling, with mineral notes that combine with hints of fresh white fruit (grapes and peaches) and, later, hints of sweet almonds and dried fruit

Flavor: Harmonious and well balanced between liveliness and roundness. The wine offers a long and fresh finish



Owned by Bruno Paillard, this domaine, of over one hundred hectares, cultivates 27 hectares of vines mainly planted to Cinsault, Mourvèdre, Syrah and Cabernet-Sauvignon and since 1995, the year of the first production, has always produced fine and elegant wines deeply respecting the terroir of Provence. In fact, this area benefit a climate with great temperature ranges that favors the growth of perfect grapes. The Côtes de Provence Rosé is the icon of the Domaine, a true archetype of the wines of the Var. The spirit of its owner, even if far from its land "friend" of Champagne, is felt through precise wines, determined and fully expressive of its terroir, all organic.
