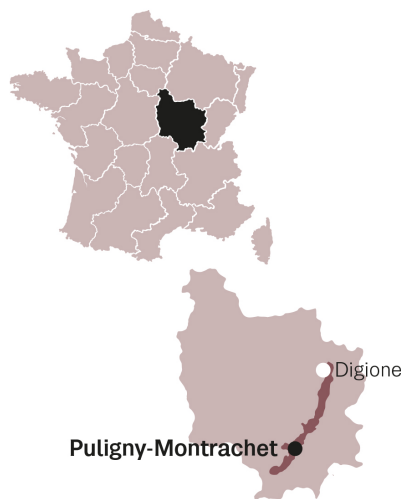

Founded in 2018 by Alvina Pernot and her husband Philippe Abadie, the Domaine vinifies grapes from several parcels in Puligny-Montrachet, supplementing them with grapes purchased from her father Paul Pernot. With only 2.3 hectares, it offers wines ranging from Grand Crus (Batard-Montrachet and Bienvenues-Batard-Montrachet) to regional wines (Bourgogne Côte d'Or Rue de Bois) and Puligny-Montrachet cuvées. The wines combine tradition and innovation, the result of sustainable practices such as light soil cultivation and minimal treatments, with extraordinary results given the young age of the Domaine and its managers. Today, Alvina Pernot is the true rising star of Puligny, embodying traditional savoir-faire and respect for the Burgundy terroir, offering authentic and refined wines.
