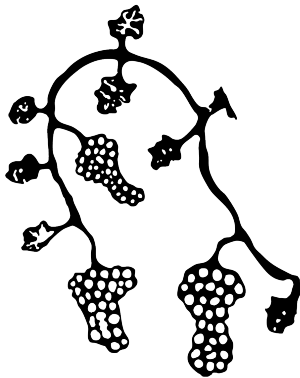

## CRISEO BOLGHERI

**Vermentino, Fiano, Verdicchio, Incrocio Manzoni, Petit Manseng**

**Production area:** Bolgheri (LI)

**Terrain:** alluvionale, profondo, sabbioso fine-argilloso, con buona presenza di ciottoli

**Harvest:** manual

**Vinification:** After a soft pressing, the must is cleaned by natural precipitation of the cold clouds. It is vinified without corrections or additions that alter the territorial characteristics of the grapes

**Refinement:** after fermentation, it is aged for 12 months in steel on the lees (fine lees) and then in the bottle

**Color:** giallo dorato e luminoso

**Fragrance:** clean and elegant, with notes of white flowers, citrus, herbs, on the finish a note of honey and sweet fruit. As we grow older, more and more mineral notes emerge

**Flavor:** Full and well balanced, with long finish

**Alcoholic Grade:** 14% vol



Michele Scienza is inside the world of wine since his childhood: the great-grandparents and the grandparents were vinegrowers in Trentino, his father Attilio a viticulture professor. After a winemaking education, in 1998 he had the opportunity to start a new life-project in Bolgheri, together with his wife Annalisa: the idea was to create a completely sustainable artisan winery. The connection with Bolgheri is thanks to his father Attilio, who studied and followed the area's winemaking evolution over the last 30 years. Knowing every inch of Bolgheri, he found this small estate, hidden among woods and hills, located in the greatest area of the appellation and devoted to viticulture since the mid-nineteenth century. Michele's work is dedicated to the production of territory wines, exploring ancient conceptions of wine-making. He personally takes care of vineyard and cellar with sensibility and skills, focusing the vinification on removing rather than adding. Today he is one of the most original interpreters of this area, with elegant and fine wines, an extraordinary personality which perfectly represent Bolgheri's terroir.
