## ESSENCE DE DOURTHE BORDEAUX

**65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 28% Merlot, 4% Cabernet Franc, 3% Petit Verdot**

**Production area:** Bordeaux

**Terrain:** .

**Harvest:** manual

**Vinification:** grapes are destemmed, sorted and then transferred by hand to small oak or stainless steel tanks for a period of pre-fermentation cold maceration before alcoholic fermentation

**Refinement:** 12-month aging provides the finishing touches to the creation of this selection of magnificent microcubes from each estate

**Color:** garnet red

**Fragrance:** Intense and complex, rich in ripe black fruits and black berries, paired to perfection with spicy notes

**Flavor:** very soft and savory, the aromas evolve rapidly, gaining remarkable breadth and intensity. Full-bodied, concentrated and silky, with lingering aromas of black cherry and currants

**Alcoholic Grade:** 14% vol
