Established in 1872 by Julien Dupont, who began exporting his products only 6 years later, at the end of the 19th century, Dupont Cognac, sold in more than fifty countries in the world, was among the icons of this distilled beverage, with awards and recognition in all countries. In 1993, Michel Boinaud, who was very close to the Dupont family, purchased the J. Dupont brand with the intention of taking it to its deserved level Only three types of Cognac are produced, low quantity, obtained mainly from Ugni blanc grapes with small quantities of Folle Blanche and Colombard and coming from a rigorously selected parcel, with an ageing being two or three times longer than the period set by law. A legend that starts again from October 2014!
