Terrain: argilloso-calcareo profondo

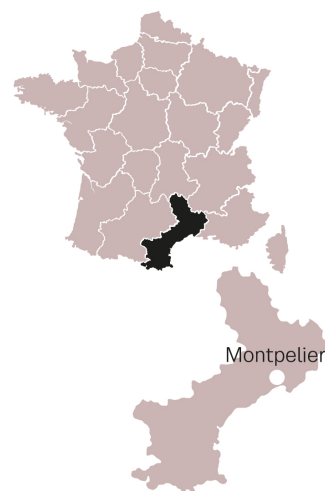
Harvest: manual
