Production area: Puligny, in the 1er Cru Perrieres

Vinification: low-temperature vertical pressing, alcoholic and malolactic fermentation in barriques, followed by light filtration

Refinement: 12 months in wooden barrels, 60% new and the rest in once-used barrels

Color: golden yellow with green highlights

Fragrance: Floral, with notes of linden and acacia. Spicy aromas with hints of custard and a touch of honey and white pepper

Flavor: full-bodied with a fresh, fragrant finish. Good balance between acidity and softness with a long finish

Alcoholic Grade: 13.5% vol



Domaine Boillot was founded in Volnay in the early 20th century by Henri Boillot who was succeeded by his son Jean. In 1975 it was the turn of Henri, grandson of the founder, who after working alongside his father became in charge of the Domaine, molding it to himself. In 1995, the négociant business was launched, while in 2000 the new Meursault winery was established, where Guillaume, Henri's son, joined his father in 2008. Hallmarks: passion and precision! The creation of a great wine starts with the vine, and dedicated care and constant attention are needed at every stage of growth, right from winter pruning. Throughout the year, maximum attention is devoted to the vineyard with limited intervention and access. Every step in the winemaking process is important, but the inherent quality of wines always depends on the care with which each individual vine is treated. Two colors, one style: Domaine Henri Boillot highlights both its terroirs and the distinct personality of its winemakers-two essential ingredients for complex, charismatic wines that are absolute landmarks of Burgundy.
